CHAPTER 203. SIGNS

Section 1. §203-1.1. Application and constructive of provisions.

This Chapter is applicable within the Incorporated Village of Lynbrook and shall be construed as an exercise of the powers of such municipality to regulate the use of signs on buildings, *structures, land, and vehicles* for outdoor advertising purposes.

Section 2. §203-4.1. Vehicles used for display of sign(s).

The Village Board has found that the use of commercial signs on the exterior parts of vehicles parked on a public roadway has created a visual blight disturbing the peace and good order of Village neighborhoods. To protect the aesthetic quality of said neighborhoods, signs may be used in connection with vehicles only in the following manner:

- A. In residential neighborhoods. One window sign with dimensions of no more than two square feet may be posted in the interior of a vehicle.
- B. In any other zone. Two window signs with dimensions of no more than two square feet may be posted in the interior of a vehicle.
- C. "Vehicle" defined. Every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway.

Section 3. This local law amendment shall be effective immediately upon filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State
