2018/2019 BUDGET REVIEW The Board met with representatives from the following Departments to review their 2018/2019 Tentative Budgets: Fire Department, Fire Department, Rent Committee and Library. Following a discussion, Trustee Becker excused himself from the meeting. The Board continued review of the Tentative Budget from the Department of Public Works, Communications, and Emergency Management Officer.

PARKING – REGAL THEATRE **RES.#92-18** It was moved by Trustee Boccio, seconded by Trustee Reardon, to amend the Parking Agreement with Regal Theatre limiting parking on certain streets for a four (4) hour period, to be between the hours of 11AM and midnight as suggested by Jerry Grewe of Regal Entertainment. DISC-SURPLUS REVENUE The Board continued review on the 2018/2019 Tentative Budget, discussed the balance of surplus reserves, use of Debt Reserve funds in 17/18, and reducing the tentative tax rate. The Mayor indicated that there would be continued review of the Tentative Budget on April 2, 2018, and Hearing on April 16, 2018.
