



Absentee Ballot Application – Lynbrook Village Election

This application must either be personally delivered to the Village Clerk not later than the day before the election, or postmarked by a governmental postal service not later than the 7th day before Election Day. The ballot itself must either be personally delivered to the Village Clerk no later than the close of polls on Election Day, or postmarked by a governmental postal service and received by the close of polls on Election Day.

Instructions:

Who may apply for an absentee ballot?

Each person must apply for themselves. It is a felony to make a false statement in an application for an absentee ballot, to attempt to cast an illegal ballot, or to help anyone to cast an illegal ballot.

Information for military or overseas voters:

If you are applying for an absentee ballot because you or your family are in the military or because you currently reside overseas, do not use this application. You are entitled to special provisions if you apply using the Federal Postcard Application. Where and when to return your application:

Applications must be mailed seven days before the election, or hand-delivered to the Village Clerk by the day before the election. The address to mail this application is:

Options available to you if you have an illness or disability:

If you check the box indicating your illness or disability is permanent, you can be entitled to automatically receive a ballot for each election in which you are eligible to vote, without having to apply again if you apply to the Nassau County Board of Elections 516/571-2411. You may sign the absentee ballot application yourself, or you may make your mark and have your mark witnessed in the spaces provided on the bottom of the application. Please note that a power of attorney or printed name stamp is not allowed for any voting purposes.

When your ballot will be sent:

Your absentee ballot materials will be sent to you approximately 20 days before the Village election in which you are eligible to vote. If you applied after this date, your ballot will be sent immediately after your completed and signed application is received and processed by the Village Clerk. If you prefer, you may designate someone to pick up your ballot for you, by completing the required information in section 5. Contact the Village Clerk if you have not received your ballot at 516/599-8300.
