P.H. & ADOPTION 2017/2018 TENTATIVE BUDGET

Budget Officer John Giordano summarized significant Reserve and Expense changes over the 2016/2017 Budget and discussed surplus levels, assessed valuation changes, and proposed changes to the 2017/2018 Tentative Budget tax rate. The Mayor asked for comments, hearing no further comments, it was moved by Trustee Beach, seconded by Trustee Reardon, to adjourn the Public Hearing, and adopt the proposed changes to the 2017/2018 Tentative Budget (Exhibit B), and adopt the Tentative Budget having a tax rate increase of 1.3%, with expenditures of \$40,728,484. Motion carried, all voting "Aye."
