

## **Press Release – Village of Lynbrook Hosting a Findings Presentation for the Greis Park Master Plan**

**The Village of Lynbrook has scheduled a Public Information Meeting on Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> at 6:30 pm – 8:00 pm at Village Hall. Please join us for a presentation of the initial findings, survey results and preliminary recommendations developed by our project consultants for Greis Park Master Plan. We want your feedback and input!**

The Village of Lynbrook is conducting a Master Plan for Greis Park. We want to hear from residents, business owners, special interest groups, and any other interested parties. Everyone is encouraged to attend.

The Master Plan will look at the existing park, recreational facilities, programs, and services, and determine the current and future level of services for the community based on public input. The plan will prioritize the needs and desires for upgrading and improving Greis Park including its amenities, programs, and services.

The Village hosted focus groups, stakeholder meetings and a public input session in January to gather information. Community input is an important part of this process and helps The Village of Lynbrook tailor the plan to reflect the community's needs,

A Needs Assessment survey was conducted in February. Approximately 3,000 surveys were mailed to a random sampling of Village of Lynbrook residents. These responses provided the statistically valid results.

In addition, all residents who did not receive the mailed invitation survey were invited to provide feedback and input through an online survey that launched at the end of February and remained open until the beginning of April. All Village of Lynbrook residents were encouraged to take the survey to share thoughts on parks and recreation needs and priorities for Greis Park. These responses will be tallied separately from the statistically valid survey and provide valuable feedback and will be included in the final report.

The results of the information gathered will be used to determine the needs and desires for upgrading and improving Greis Park's, recreational facilities, amenities, programs, and services.

The Village of Lynbrook has hired GreenPlay, LLC, a nationally-known parks and recreation management consulting firm to oversee the plan.
