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## **2024 Guidelines**

Below is a list of guidelines that should be adhered to by all gardeners during the upcoming season. Failure to abide by these guidelines may result in forfeiture of your plot.

- All plots should be weeded and under cultivation no later than June 1. After that time, any plots not cultivated will be deemed to be abandoned and assigned to someone else.
- **Gardeners need to maintain their plot throughout the gardening season.** Plots overgrown with weeds are unsightly and diminish the overall appearance. Also weed seeds germinate creating additional work for everyone. Plants that tend to sprawl (e.g. squash, melons, etc.) need to be contained within your bed.
- **Each gardener is responsible for weeding the paths around their bed as well as the area at the end of their bed.**
- Any weeds should be bagged and placed by the main gate. There are trash bags available in the shed. Do not pile the weeds or toss them over the fence on the east side of the garden. The same applies to any damaged or rotten produce.
- The tools in the shed are for community garden use. Please take care of them so that they last for many seasons. When you're finished using them, clean any dirt / mud off of them and place them neatly in the shed for the next gardener to use.
- Please coil the hoses after using them so that we can keep the paths clear **and make sure the water is turned off !!**
- No pets are permitted in the garden at any time.
- Children and guests (and their actions) are "Gardeners" responsibility and must remain under their supervision at all times
- There is a \$10.00 charge for replacement of lost keys, payable at Village Hall.
- **Garden plots must be cleaned out by November 30<sup>th</sup>. Failure to do so may result in losing your plot the following year.**
