**The Spotted Lanternfly is a destructive pest.
Keep it out of your property!**



Egg masses or residue can be found year-round, but most likely from fall to early summer.



1st - 3rd instar nymphs are found early spring through mid-summer. 4th instars are seen through the fall.

Adults: Found feeding on a wide variety of plants, but Tree-of-Heaven is often preferred, if present.



Adults emerge by late summer or early fall.
